

Review Process: Awards of more than £100k

Expression of Interest (Eoi) Stage

Applicants submit a short application form with a brief overview of their proposal.



Internal triage

Eois are triaged by Foundation staff, based on completeness and eligibility of the applicant.



Eoi review

At least 2 scientific members of our RRC and 1 member affected by MND provides a written review and score for each Eoi.



Full Application stage

The highest ranking Eois are invited to submit a Full Application. All applicants are provided with feedback.



Full Application written review

At least 3 scientific members of our RRC and 1 member affected by MND provides a written review and score for each Full Application.

1 lead reviewer



Full Application in-person meeting

Lead reviewer presents to RRC at the panel meeting and all RRC members present score the application. Applications are ranked and a final discussion determines which applications are recommended for funding to the Board of Trustees.



Notification of outcome

Awards are offered. All applicants (both successful and unsuccessful) are provided with feedback.

Review Process: Awards of up to £100k

Application stage

Applicants submit an application detailing the proposal.



Internal triage

Applications are triaged by Foundation staff, based on completeness and eligibility of the applicant.



Application review

At least 3 scientific members of our RRC and 1 member affected by MND provides a written review and score for each application.



Ranking and final decision

Applications are ranked and the committee Chair makes the final decision on which applications are recommended for funding to the Board of Trustees. A meeting with the whole committee will be held if further discussion is required.



Notification of outcome

Awards are offered. All applicants (both successful and unsuccessful) are provided with feedback.
